## WABASH COLLEGE MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

### Domestic Students Entering Wabash in 2025-2026\*

Scholarship amounts are renewable annually for four years.

Grades and test scores will be reviewed through May 1, 2025.

<b>Early Decision Scholarship</b> \$4,000 scholarship in addition to merit.	Apply Early Decision to the College by November 15, 2024.	A holistic review of your academic achievements, including grade trend, strength of curriculum, test scores (if submitted), and class rank (if available).
<b>**Honors Scholarship</b> \$2,000 scholarship per year for four years with potential to earn up to a full-tuition scholarship.	Apply for admission to the College by December 1, 2024.	Attend Scarlet Honors Weekend, December 6-7, 2024 <b>OR</b> February 16-17, 2025.
<b>Wabash College Lilly Awards</b> Tuition, fees, on-campus housing and food each year. More than \$240,000 over four years.	Complete application for admission and submit the Lilly Award application by January 5, 2025.	Based on character, creativity, and academic accomplishment. Finalists interviewed February 23–24, 2025.
<b>**File Your FAFSA</b> \$1,000 scholarship in addition to merit, renewable for four years.	Complete application for admission and file a FAFSA.	Must be admitted to the College. No additional selection criteria.
<b>**Campus Visit</b> \$1,000 scholarship in addition to merit, renewable for four years.	Complete application for admission and attend any campus visit, except Scarlet Honors Weekend.	Must be admitted to the College. No additional selection criteria.

## NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID FOR INDIANA STUDENTS

- Academically qualified Federal Pell Grant recipients from Indiana with an SAI of \$7,500 or less will receive grants to reduce direct costs to \$3,000 annually after utilizing Federal Student Loans.
- Academically qualified students from families residing in Indiana with adjusted gross incomes up to \$125,000 will receive grants to lower the Wabash tuition and fees equivalent to tuition and fees at the state's flagship university.
- Students must complete a FAFSA prior to April 15, 2025 and must have a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$7,500 or less.

## WABASH COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID PROCESS CHECKLIST

STEP 1

**WHAT:** Create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID (one for the student, one for the parent)

**WHY:** FSA IDs are used to electronically sign the FAFSA

**WHERE:** Apply at <https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account>

**WHEN:** Due as soon as possible and is necessary to submit the FAFSA

STEP 2

**WHAT:** Complete Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

**WHY:** To apply for eligible need-based financial assistance at the federal and state levels (including Federal Direct Student and Parent PLUS Loans)

**WHERE:** Complete at <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/>

**WHEN:** Please submit by February 1, 2025 for Wabash processing (State of Indiana deadline is April 15, 2025)
